- **b. Spring Workshops**—Big success—All 3 classes. Ideas for next year?? *New classes will be considered as volunteer teachers are found. The list generated from the May meeting included a horseman class, art class, backcountry survival class, fly fishing class, square dancing, and weed class.*
- c. Grants—County Parks & Trails Grant: We have good "match funding" (need 50% for this grant, and we have a generous donor who will help). Should we try to spend the rest of the County funds to get the women's toilet fixed and/or hot water heater drained/cleaned? Steve King acknowledged some procrastination and confusion in amending the current grant. The Board clarified repair priorities to include fixing the leaky toilet, repair of the leaky in-line drip fixtures, maintenance of the water heater, and checking and charging the pressure tanks.

 Montana History Foundation Grant: Completion Report done! Final check (\$800) received. Any updates from Mark Tomell as to when he'll complete the work? Mark is completing the stone cap and veneer on the back stairs, and he will be starting the window sill repair work.

Karen Murphy sent out an email blast promoting the event. The Board discussed roles to cover the event including staffing the bar-be-que, food supplies on hand, and trash pick-up after the event.
