## Preserving Nine Mile History through Photographs

To that end, your NMCC Board of Directors applied for a Preserving Missoula County's History Grant sponsored by the Historical Museum at Fort Missoula. The grant will fund part of the costs to print and frame images of the Nine Mile community. And now we need your help!

Do you have photos showing activities at the Nine Mile Community Center? It doesn't matter if they're 1 or 50

years old--we're interested in collecting visual history of all vintages. We hope to tell a picture story of the evolution of the Stark School from its beginning in 1915 as a rural school building, into our present-day active community center.

We'll select the best and most interesting images and information to create a display on the walls inside the Stark Schoolhouse. Our goal is to have the first phase of this project completed by July 4th, in time for the ATV/UTV Parade and community BBQ. For that reason, we've set a deadline of April 30 to accept materials, so we have time to sort, select, print, frame, and assemble the display.
