Your Frenchtown Rural Fire Department can help reduce your home's risk from wildfire BEFORE smoke is in the air!

Our wildfire risk reduction specialists will assess your property, make recommendations, assist with project planning, and do the work. Our grant-funded cost-share program pays ¾ of your project's cost.

Risk assessment: Our Hazard Fuels Reduction crew will assess the hazards potentially affecting your house and property by appointment, *free of charge*, prior to any project, *regardless* of whether you choose to hire us.

Projects: We specialize in cutting and removing vegetation such as saplings, small-diameter trees, and brush. Cut material can be chipped, or, in special circumstances, piled for later burning by the homeowner.

Benefits: By reducing vegetation around your property, you lessen the intensity of wildland fire affecting your home. This lessens the risk not only to your home, but also to fire personnel assigned to protect it in the event of a wildfire emergency. Help us help you!



Other Information

- We bid based on project cost. Incident response, crew size, and unanticipated project difficulties will NOT result in increased cost to you.
- Past projects have ranged in size from less than ¼ acre to over 15 acres.
- Projects have been completed for as little as \$150 cost to the homeowner.
